- ***Discussion of smoking policy and tobacco use on this campus. With Chancellor Davis and Gary Beisel**
 - Some non-smoking students are unhappy with students smoking outside of building doors. They don't want to be exposed to smoke. Some smoking students find it unfair to travel to the smoking stations. What is the solution?

History of the policy- All tobacco products have only been permitted to use in the designated areas.

-It is not reasonable to try and make this campus smoke free. We tried to make it better by installing these smoking stations away from buildings.

-As student leaders if we see smoking in any area other than the designated areas, we should ask them to smoke somewhere else. If they refuse ask security to take care of it. If it becomes an issue they will be asked to leave campus until they are finished smoking

-The signs on campus should be reworded from "Smoking Permitted in designated areas" to "No Smoking" and be located near the entrances of the campus.

-Why can faculty and staff smoke near buildings? It has been an issue that has been called out by Chancellor Davis, and staff is trying to be respectful.

- Littering Fine? We do not have security to stand outside of all buildings at all hours of the day to see who is littering their butts. We also cannot impose a littering fine, only law enforcement can do that.

- If we have more smoking stations closer to buildings, we feel as though we are encouraging smoking.

- As respect to nonsmokers, we ask that you please smoke in the designated areas as University Policy states. We will try to install one more smoking area on this campus, and the Just Do It Committee has volunteered to choose a spot. Talk to Donovan if you are interested in deciding where this station should be.

- We need to make sure all smokers know where the designated areas are located and also have opportunities for students to stop smoking. Great American Smoke out and other workshops to promote quitting.
